The buzz! Europe-based Just Eat Takeaway, a merger between U.K.'s Just Eat and Netherlands-based Takeaway, is set to acquire its US competitor Grubhub in a \$7.3B deal, beating out Uber. The new company will have an active customer base of 70M. When the pandemic forced restaurants to close on-site dining and find other ways to stay in business, Glasserie, a Brooklyn, N.Y. Mediterranean restaurant, experimented with delivery and takeout apps including Seamless, Grubhub and DoorDash.
