September 2nd 2020: Keeping Older Loved Ones Safe During COVID-19

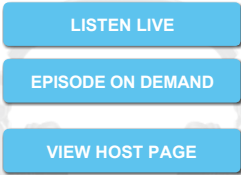

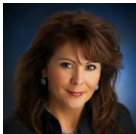
Bruce Mann, MD FACP
