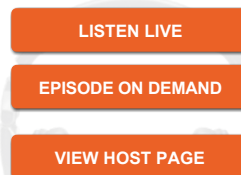

Dr Suzanne Doyle-Morris, is the author of 'The Con Job: Getting Ahead for Competence in a World Obsessed with Confidence'. She is completely focused on helping professional women get the roles they want and the recognition they deserve. 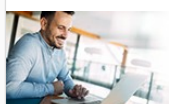
