October 19th 2017: Couples and Their Couple Friendships

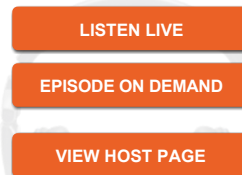

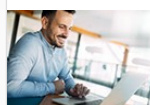
