June 7th 2021: Ep. 184: The Inevitability of Being Compromised

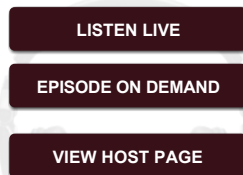

J.J. Guy is co-founder & CEO of Sevco Security. Sevco is an enterprise security company helping IT and Security Operations Teams operationalize asset management. Before Sevco, Mr. Guy was the CTO of JASK, the first cloud-native SaaS SIEM, acquired by Sumo Logic in 2019. He was also part of the founding team of Carbon Black, where they created the first endpoint telemetry platform, which Gartner later branded Endpoint Detection and Response. Carbon Black's telemetry enabled the industry to operationalize detection and response as part of day to day operations at a speed and efficiency not possible with traditional DFIR tools. Before Carbon Black, J.J. spent 12 years with various federal
