**March 15th 2013: Navigating the Cancer Maze with stage 4 Lymphoma survivor and therapist Debby Franke Ogg**

Debby Franke Ogg's story of unexpected remission from stage 4 nodular lymphoma was the basis for the 1988 feature film a Leap of Faith, also called A Question of Faith starring Anne Archer and Sam Neill. Following a miscarriage, aged 40; Debby was told that she had nodular lymphoma; a poor prognosis & no cure. She chose not have conventional treatments of the day as she was told there was little hope of success. Although she had no hope with her treatment; she encourages patients to accept viable medical treatments. In 2013; as a 27 year survivor, Debby continues to inspire others. Now a thera
