May 14th 2013: Caregiver Support Program with Mrs. Anita Mingo LICSW Caregiver Support Coordinator

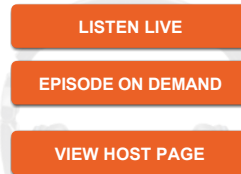
