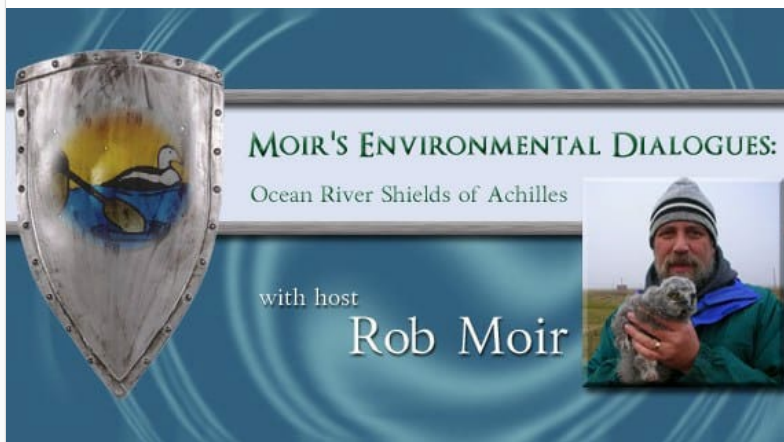

December 31st 2015:Encore: Lake Baikal Troubles and Solutions in the Sacred Sea

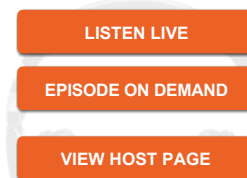
