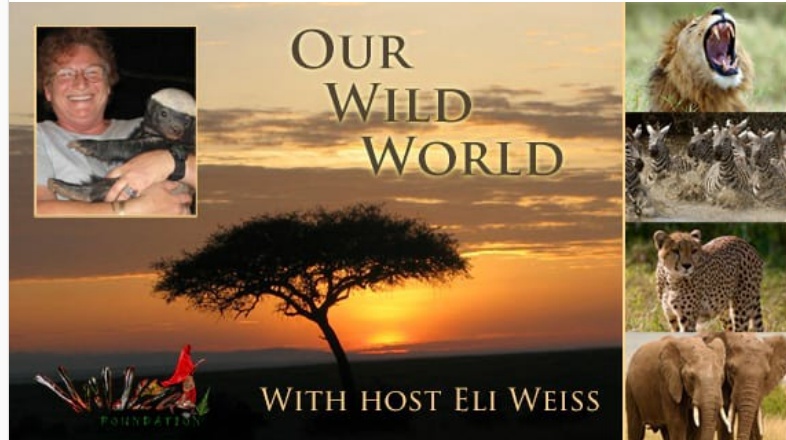

August 29th 2016: Dreaming Big with Richard Bonham, Big Life Foundation

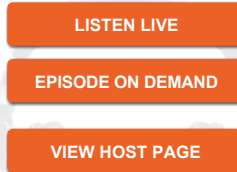

Richard Bonham

Richard Bonham grew up and lived the bush and conservation as the son of game warden Jack Bonham. From flying in the Sudan, Zaire and East Africa, he returned to E. Africa and the safari business and has been a pioneer ever since. From creating the Community Game Scouts with Maasai warriors collecting snares to co-founding Big Life Foundation, to the Maaasailand Preservation Trust setting up health clinics, schools and a wildlife scholarship program that has put hundreds of students through school. From there Big Life pioneered the Predator Compensation Project, an economic incentive based approach securing a future for predators and co-existence within communities. In the mid 90's he was
