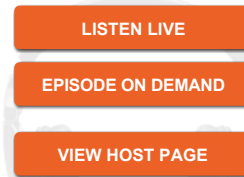

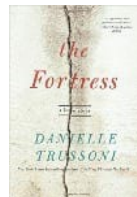

Years later after moving to the United States, she attended the University Of Colorado Medical School and completed her residency in pediatrics and fellowship in neonatology at Duke University while simultaneously raising four young children. She is the inventor of the Turtle, an FDA-cleared infant repositioning device designed to prevent and eliminate flat head syndrome, and is the founder of Turtle Products, LLC, which sells and distributes the Turtle as well as other products to help hospitalized infants with optimal head positioning.
